

REPORT ON PA EXHIBITION AT VISHWABHARATI PUBLIC SCHOOL, NEYYATTINKARA

On invitation from Vishwabharati Public School, Neyyattinkara, Trivandrum, a public awareness exhibition was organized on 6th and 7th November 2014, on the occasion of the school annual science festival.

The programme was inaugurated by Shri. A.T.George, MLA of Parassala. He visited KKNPP exhibition and showed keen interest in understanding the safety features of KKNPP.



He suggested that such awareness measures should be spread far and wide so that undue fear about nuclear energy among the masses could be dispelled. He told the gathering that as Indians, we should be proud of KKNPP, which is a wonderful feat of science and technology.



During the two days, around 4000 visitors, including school children, their parents, teachers and local public visited KKNPP exhibition. Around 32000 information pamphlets were distributed. 100 books on article by Dr. A.P.J.Abdul Kalam and Dr. M.R.Srinivasan were given to the teachers and school library.



The response from the students, teachers and other people was very enthusiastic. Students of higher secondary group showed keen interest in the process of generation of electricity from a nuclear power plant, nuclear fission and fish protection facility.

Many doubts and queries were raised by the parents and other visitors on the safety aspects of NPP, effects of radiation and effect of KKNPP on environment and marine life. Some expressed their apprehensions on disposal of nuclear waste too.

The 5 member team from KKNPP cleared their doubts and queries satisfactorily.
