

Report on Scientific Meet on Radiation and Cancer organized for the Doctors of RRA Podar Ayurveda Cancer Research and other Institutes on 26-04-2013

NPCIL has been organizing a series of scientific meets on Radiation and Cancer for doctors and paramedical staff at various places across the country to allay the unfounded fears about radiation & cancer and nuclear safety issues.

On the same lines, another Scientific Meet was organized on April 26, 2013 at Auditorium of Textiles Committee, Near Tata Press & Kismat Cinema, Prabhadevi, Mumbai. The doctors and paramedical staff of several Mumbai based hospitals like RRA Podar Ayurveda Cancer Research Institute, NIRRH (ICMR), YMT Ayurvedic College, KGM Ayurvedic College, NIMA, National Rural Health Mission (AYUSH cell), and SGS Medical college & KEM Hospital participated in the programme.
