PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAMME REPORT ON ALL INDIA SEMINAR

An all India seminar on recent trends in power sector and quality of power organized by Institution of Engineers was held at Chennai between 30th August and 31st August 2013. Experts from different walks of power sector participated in the seminar. Around 22 technical papers were presented. Presented papers threw light on technical aspects of various modes of power generation, power transmission, and distribution of power.

On the inaugural function Shri T.J. Kotteeswaran, SD, MAPS participated and S/Shri S. Rathakrishnan and S. Selvam of MAPS took part as participants of the seminar on both the days. A souvenir was also brought out incorporating a paper from MAPS elaborating the need of Nuclear power and this souvenir is said to be sent to large industries and organizations throughout India and expected to reach large number of Engineers as the enrolled no of engineers in Institution of engineers is about 0.6 million. Operation Superintendent of Madras Atomic power Station, Shri M. Venkatachalam made a presentation on the need for Nuclear energy in Indian scenario-The glimpses of its advantages, potential & safety.

He emphasized the importance Nuclear power, safety of nuclear power plants n India. He stressed the need of Nuclear power in the present scenario of our country and briefed about the natural background radiation and its origin. He elaborated the capabilities of our plants to withstand natural calamities by referring the incidents of Tsunami which struck Kalpakkam coast on 26th December 2004 and how the Atomic power plant was safely shut down. The message was well received by the audience comprising the reputed engineering college students Electricity board officials and engineers involved in power sector. Student's fraternity was enthusiastic and interacted with MAPS participants and got cleared their doubts about Nuclear power and radiation safety. In highlight of the program Honorable minister for power Govt.of Tamilnadu addressed the gathering. He asserted the importance of power, different power generation scenario and various upcoming power projects in Tamilnadu.
