

Nuclear power awareness programmes extended to non-elite schools in Hindi language

In line with its strategy of maximizing outreach to diverse sections of community, the CP&CC Directorate commenced its campaign in non-elite schools of Mumbai addressing students in the instructional medium.

2 batches of around 160 students were imparted awareness on the beneficial aspects of nuclear power at the Vivekananda High School and Jr College, Koperkhairne, Navi Mumbai by NPCIL resource-persons on Feb 17th and 18th. The impartation was done in Hindi language – the medium of instruction at the school.
