Activities carried out under Category A for the month of March, 2022

1. As a part of the celebrations of the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava, NPCIL in order to showcase the progress of the department since inception arranged a Press Meet for the media representatives from nearby areas of Kakrapara. The program was informative, interactive, lively and appreciated by all.
2. At the NPCIL sites where new plants are coming up like GHAVP, as a part of the celebrations of the 75th year of Indian Independence public outreach programs were conducted for the teachers and students of the nearby schools to make them aware of the basics of Nuclear Energy and its benefits to the society.
3. To celebrate Indian Independence and highlight the contributions of Atomic Energy in the development of the nation as Aatmanirbhar Bharat, the model of the 700 MWe indigenously designed Pressurized Heavy Water Reactor was handed over to the Dharwad Science Center, Karnataka by Training Superintendent, KGS Shri M. Seshaiyah to the Director, Dharwad Science Centre.
4. In order to commemorate the celebrations, a special webinar series on technical / soft-skill development has been started by NPCIL for the benefit of all its employees. As a part of this series, three technical sessions as follows were organized on Sundays via the google meet digital platform so that all the employees from all the sites of NPCIL may be able to take the benefit of the session for honing up their technical knowledge and skill:
 - a. Environmental Management for Nuclear Power Projects / Plants by Dr. Jitendra Singh ACE(ESG)
 - b. Nuclear Power an Option for India's Elixir's for Climate by Dr. Jitendra Singh ACE(ESG)
 - c. Radiation – A Companion to Life by Shri. Venkataramana (ACE(HS&E))
5. To commemorate the occasion and the celebrations, a special edition of the annual Hindi magazine, Anukanya was released by the KKNPP Site celebrating 75 years of Indian Independence.
6. In order to celebrate 75 years of Indian Independence, the Pelican Nature Club of Kudankulam, Harrier Nature Club of Tarapur and Ibis Nature Club Kakrapara organized Bird Marathons for the bird count to sight and record the birds in the region where our plants are located under the aegis of NPCIL's Environment Stewardship Program (ESP).
7. A session on Nuclear Energy as an inevitable option for the Future was organized at the Social Enclave organized by Narsee Monjee Institute of Management Studies as a part of the celebrations of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava.
8. As a part of the celebrations, a total of 61 outreach programs were organized during the month, comprising of 53 site visits and 07 lectures (including online / webinars) and 01 exhibition imparting awareness to 1, 26,060 were organized in March.
