**Activities carried out under Category A for the month of October, 2021**

1. A special interview of CMD, NPCIL was televised under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava on Sansad TV, recording a viewership of about 50,000.
2. Under the special drive as a part of the celebrations of the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava for interacting with the outgoing students of Atomic Energy Central Schools (AECS) pan India making them aware about the glorious nuclear energy power program and taking them through a journey of NPCIL and its contribution in the service of the nation, special webinar sessions were arranged for AECS-1 Mumbai, AECS-2, Mumbai, AECS-5, Mumbai, AECS-4, Mumbai and Atomic Energy Junior College, AEJC, Mumbai. By means of these webinars a total of about 251 students and 31 teachers were reached out.
3. Also a quiz related to the nuclear energy program of India and the history of use of nuclear energy for peaceful purposes and production of electricity and related topics were conducted and the winning students from each of the above schools were felicitated by mementoes from NPCIL.
4. A total of 11 lectures were organized during the month, imparting awareness to 661 persons including through the webinar mode. This is in addition to the 12 lectures during site visits comprising of 124 persons including officials and their family members.
5. Around 81,600 people visited the Science Centres featuring Hall of Nuclear Power (Mumbai, Chennai and Delhi) and District Science Centres at Goa, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh, Dharampur, Hyderabad, Kalimpong, Gulbarga, Burla and Bellari which display interactive models of the nuclear power plants and Miniature Nuclear Galleries at Chandigarh, Pushpa Gujral, Kota, Mangaluru, Karwar and Bhopal.
6. Awareness on nuclear energy was imparted to around 1,32,000 persons during the month by NPCIL through programmes such as site visits, webinars, visits to science centres, etc.
