1.0 Introduction

NPCIL has been implementing Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) projects since its inception as per the commitment to economic and social development of the community living around 16 Km radius from all its Units. CSR programme is generally implemented as per the identified need of the community. The thrust areas for CSR programme are: education, healthcare, infrastructure development, skill development, and sustainable development.

With the Companies Act 2013, making CSR mandatory for the eligible companies, the CSR programme has been strengthened since FY 2017-18 with further delegation of financial powers for speedy implementation. A two tier structure comprising the Unit CSR Cell and Site Level Committee manages the CSR projects at the sites. At Headquarters, the Tier II Committee and the Board Sub-Committee on CSR and Sustainability steer the corporate CSR programme.

2.0 CSR Programme

As per the Section 135 of Companies Act 2013 and CSR Rules, after setting off previous year's (2023-24) excess spent, NPCIL Board allocated ₹162.02 Crore for implementation of CSR Activities and NPCIL has spent ₹168.50 Crore during the FY 2024-25. The spending was done in total 99 new projects and 157 on-going projects in nine categories. The amount spent is more than the prescribed amount and there is no unspent CSR amount for FY 2024-25. Total number of new CSR projects initiated this year in different categories at the Units of NPCIL is given in the table below. It may be noted that expenditure was incurred only in 99 out of 173 new projects.

2.1 Thrust areas for CSR projects

The thrust areas for CSR projects are: education, healthcare, infrastructure development, skill development and sustainable development.

Thrust area as per the DPE Guidelines received from time to time are; i) to carryout spending in the Aspirational Districts and ii) DPE theme on Health & Nutrition for year 2024-25.

2.1.1 Under education category the projects like construction of school buildings, class rooms, Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) lab., astronomical lab., science and mathematical park, establishment of smart classes, furniture for schools, deployment of teachers in schools, improvement in learning outcome through various technological interventions, training and education to children with special need; assistance to schools by providing drinking water, toilets, multi-purpose hall, library up gradation, boundary wall, roof between two buildings for multipurpose use, prayer stage with shed; flooring; Bunsen burner with LPG gas pipe line; assistance to students by providing cycles, computers, books, note books, school bags, shoes, school kits, uniforms, scholarship etc. were taken up during this year.

2.1.2 Under healthcare, the CSR projects included running of primary health centre and OPD services at Tarapur Maharashtra Site, Narora Atomic Power Station, Kakrapar Gujarat Site and Kaiga Generating Station; providing mobile medical van services at Tarapur Maharashtra Site, Kakrapar Gujarat Site, Kaiga Generating Station, Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project, Gorakhpur Haryana Anu Vidyut Pariyojana and Chutka Madhya Pradesh Atomic Power Project; organising medical, eye and special health care camps; labour rooms and waiting sheds for Primary Health Centres (PHCs), medical equipment and ambulance for hospitals, supply of medical kits, mission to end TB by 2025; providing

vaccine carrier to Government authorities, provision of open air gym and sewage treatment plant, providing assistive devices to differently abled persons including senior citizens and nutrition supplementation, development of aganwadis, kitchen shed, mid-day meal shelters, supply of garbage collection and other cleaning equipment, development of drinking water facility and erection of water treatment plant, installation of RO Plant, water filters and coolers etc. Contribution was also made to Tata Memorial Centre, Mumbai and Madan Mohan Malviya Cancer Centre & Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital, Varanasi for the purchase of equipment.

2.1.3 Skill development initiatives were undertaken to ensure income generation for unemployed adults. Skills in tailoring, computers, CNC machines, domestic electrical appliances, fashion designing, assistant electrician, fitter, machinist, turner, tool and die maker, engagement of trade apprentices etc. were focussed upon.

Tarapur Maharashtra Site implemented AKRUTI (Advance Knowledge & Rural Technology Implementation) project at Boisar. This aims to create awareness about technologies developed by BARC and other DAE units and propagate different technologies for rural development and entrepreneurship development in nearby villages. These technologies are rapid bio composting, fish processing, soil carbon detection techniques, tele ECG, infra-red dryer, water purifiers, neem biopesticide, seed multiplication etc.

2.1.4 Under infrastructure development, the projects like laying of approach roads with drains, footpath, retaining wall and culverts, construction of bridge, construction of community hall and traffic awareness and counselling centre, construction of water tanks and lift irrigation facilities, procurement of JCB vehicles for water body maintenance, construction of cremation shed and bus stops, establishment of District Disaster Control, Co-ordination Centre and District Relief Co-ordination Centre at Tirunelveli, T. N., purchase of fire vehicle, provision of street lights including LED ones, installation of CCTV system with automatic no. plate recognition etc. were taken up.

2.1.5 Some sustainable development initiatives were also undertaken this year. These included projects like rainwater harvesting, ground/ underground natural water bodies, irrigation system, ponds, solar street lights, solar power plants, establishment of butterfly park etc.

2.1.6 As regards CSR projects in Aspirational Districts, organising eye camps including conducting cataract operation and other eye surgeries at aspirational districts Begusarai, Aurangabad, Jamui, Khagaria, Muzzafarpur, Nawada and Sitamarhi in Bihar. Construction

of two labour room, one solar panel and construction of four anganwadi centres at Aheri, Bhamragad, Sironcha and Gadchiroli blocks at aspirational district Gadchiroli in Maharashtra were done. Establishment of Oxygen Plant at aspirational district Dahod and ICU on wheels at aspirational district Narmada in Gujarat were done. Supply of seven mini ambulances to aspirational district Alluri, Sita Rama Raju and supply of three mini ambulances to aspirational district Parvatipuram Manyam in Andhra Pradesh were carried out. Supply of Dialysis machines to aspirational district Raichur in Karnataka was done. Provided vaccine van to aspirational district Chamba in Himachal Pradesh. Supported cyclone affected persons at aspirational block in Tamil Nadu. In all 10 projects were carried out in 15 aspirational districts/ aspirational block in different states.

3.0 Highlights/ Major achievements

3.1 Education

3.1.1 Construction of School building in village Katumbi, Banswara at Rajasthan

Construction of Government Senior Secondary School building at village Katumbi was carried out. This year expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 647.48 lakh and it will benefit around 6000 students. This will reduce dropout rate.



3.1.2 Improvement in learning through technological interventions, Banswara at Rajasthan

Improvement in learning outcome in Government Schools located near Site through various technological interventions was carried out. This year ₹ 268.05 lakh has been spent on this project. This will benefit around 100000 students.



3.1.3 Distribution of computers and furniture to school near Tarapur at Maharashtra

Computers, printers, table and chairs were distributed to Zila Parishad schools located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. This would help school children in learning computers and promote e-learning.



3.1.4 Distribution of notebooks to school students near Tarapur at Maharashtra

Notebooks were distributed to Zila Parishad schools located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. Number of beneficiaries were 15000 and estimated cost of this project is ₹ 68 lakh. This will reduce drop out rate.



3.1.5 Cycle distribution to Girl students, Tarapur at Maharashtra

Cycle distribution to needy Girl students were carried out. Number of beneficiaries would be 200. Cost of this project was ₹ 13.05 lakh. The project will help in reducing drop out cases.



3.2 Sanitation

3.2.1 Construction of toilet blocks near Kudankulam at Tamil Nadu

Construction of toilet blocks at nine schools located near Kudankulam were completed. Around 1227 students would be benefitted by this project. Cost of this project was ₹ 210.49 lakh.



3.2.2 Construction of toilet blocks near Gorakhpur at Haryana

Construction of toilet blocks at village Matana was completed. Around 20000 persons would be benefitted by this project. This year ₹ 155.38 lakh was spent on this project. This will prevent germs from spreading into the environment.



3.3 Skill Development

3.3.1 Skill development training, Tarapur at Maharashtra

Skill development training is being provided to the neighbourhood youth through CIPET, Navsari. The training was provided on plastic processing and CNC lathe. Cost of this project was ₹ 115.74 lakh. No. of persons trained were 100.



3.3.2 Skill Development Training near Rawatbhata at Rajasthan

Skill development training on stitching and tailoring was provided to 120 females residing near Rawatbhata. This year ₹ 57.03 lakh was spent on the project. The project will ensure females to earn their livelihood on their own.



3.4 Health Services

3.4.1 Mobile Medical Van for Project affected persons, Chutka at Madhya Pradesh

Mobile medical van with a team of doctors and nurse were put into services for project affected persons residing at Gram Panchayat Patha, Konda and Manegaon. The mobile medical van is being run by M/s Hindustan Latex Family Planning Promotion Trust.



3.4.2 Provision of ambulances and MM Units to PHCs near Tarapur at Maharashtra

Ambulances and mobile medical Units were provided to Primary Health Centres, Tarapur, Chinchani, Dandi and Morbe located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. This would increase availability of medical facilities in the surrounding area.



3.5.3 Distribution of nutrition kit to pregnant women at PHC, Tarapur at Maharashtra

Nutrition kits were distributed to surrounding pregnant/ malnourished women at Primary Health Centre, Tarapur. The project was implemented through District Health Officer,

Palghar.



3.4.4 Health camp for school students studying near Tarapur at Maharashtra

Health camp was conducted for school students studying in nearby localities of Site. Number of beneficiaries were 110000 and estimated cost of this project is ₹ 340 lakh. The project will help in reducing drop out cases.



3.4.5 Assisting differently abled persons, Tarapur at Maharashtra

Assessment camp was conducted for differently abled persons including senior citizens for providing assistive devices through ALIMCO. The project will benefit 11000 persons and estimated cost of this project is ₹ 450 lakh.



3.5 Infrastructure Development

3.5.1 Construction of bituminous road at Nanicher near Kakrapar, Gujarat

Construction of bituminous road at village Nanicher was carried out. This will ensure better mobility especially during rainy season for the people residing in the surrounding villages. Cost of this project was ₹ 98.48 lakh.



3.5.2 Construction of bituminous road at village Kumbhavali near Tarapur, Maharashtra

Construction of bituminous and CC road at village Kumbhavali and others were carried out near Tarapur. Bituminous road of 1288.50 mtr. length and C C road of 2398.60 mtr.length were constructed. So far ₹ 243.71 lakh has been spent on this project.



3.6 Environmental Sustainability

3.6.1 Solar Plant at Rawatbhata Hospital, Rajasthan

50 KVA solar plant was supplied and installed at Rawatbhata Hospital. Number of beneficiaries would be 14500. This year ₹ 22.40 lakh was spent on the project. Solar power is a clean power.



3.7.1 Installation of solar street lights at Mahi Banswara, Rajasthan

Installation of solar street lights 50 no. were carried out at nearby villages of Mahi Banswara in two phases. This year expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 12.49 lakh. This will benefit around 9000 persons of the surrounding area.



4.0 CSR Expenditure

The total expenditure of ₹ 168.50 Crore was incurred on the CSR programme in FY 2024-25 against the CSR fund allocation of ₹ 162.02 Crore. The details of expenditure on CSR programme in FY 2024-25 are given in the table below:

5.0 Unit CSR Reports

This section consists of unit CSR reports. A total of 99 new projects and 189 on-going projects were taken up during the year by the units. The major CSR projects completed as well as under progress at different units are given in this section.

5.1 CSR at Tarapur Maharashtra Site (TMS)

CSR projects were implemented in around 44 villages located within 16 Km radius from T M Site. TMS was allocated ₹ 1589.19 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2024-25. Using this fund, TMS initiated 11 new CSR projects and also executed 11 on-going projects. Glimpses of some of the projects in 2024-25 are provided below.

5.1.1 Distribution of notebooks to school students near Tarapur

Notebooks were distributed to Zila Parishad schools located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. Number of beneficiaries were 15000 and estimated cost of this project is ₹ 68 lakh. This will reduce dropout rate.



5.1.2 Distribution of computers and furniture to school near Tarapur

Computers, printers, table and chairs were distributed to Zila Parishad schools located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. This would help school children in learning computers and promote e-learning.



5.1.3 Skill development training near Tarapur

Skill development training is being provided to the neighbourhood youth through CIPET, Navsari. The training was provided on plastic processing and CNC lathe. Cost of this project was ₹ 115.74 lakh. No. of persons trained were 100.



5.1.4 Distribution of Health ATM to PHC, Chinchani near Tarapur

Health ATM was supplied to Primary Health Centre, Chinchani which is located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. This would increase availability of medical facilities in the surrounding area.



5.1.5 Provision of ambulance and mobile medical Units to PHCs near Tarapur

Ambulances and mobile medical units were provided to Primary Health Centres, Tarapur, Chinchani, Dandi and Morbe located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. This would increase availability of medical facilities in the surrounding area.



5.1.6 Health camp for school students studying near Tarapur

Health camp was conducted for school students studying in nearby localities of Site. Number of beneficiaries were 110000 and estimated cost of this project is ₹ 340 lakh. The project will help in reducing drop out cases.



5.1.7 Distribution of nutrition kit to pregnant women at PHC, Tarapur

Nutrition kits were distributed to surrounding pregnant/ malnourished women at Primary Health Centre, Tarapur. The project was implemented through District Health Officer, Palghar.



5.1.8 Cycle distribution to Girl students near Tarapur

Cycle distribution to needy Girl students were carried out. Number of beneficiaries would be 200. Cost of this project was ₹ 13.05 lakh. The project will help in reducing drop out cases.



5.1.9 Assisting differently abled persons near Tarapur

Assessment camp was conducted for differently abled persons including senior citizens for providing assistive devices through ALIMCO. The project will benefit 11000 persons and estimated cost of this project is ₹ 450 lakh.



5.1.10 Eye Camp through Sri Chaitanya Health and Care Trust near Tarapur

Eye Camp was organized through Sri Chaitanya Health and Care Trust at Tarapur. Cost of this project was ₹ 11.30 lakh. The camp would benefit around 1000 villagers residing within 16 Km radius of Site.



5.1.11 Construction of anganwadi at Mahagoan at Gadchiroli

Construction of anganwadi at village Mahagoan at aspirational district Gadchiroli was carried out. No. of persons benefitted would be 7000. So far ₹ 51.58 lakh has been spent on this project.



5.1.12 Construction of multipurpose hall at Kurgoan near Tarapur

Construction of multipurpose hall at village Kurgoan was carried out which is located in the surrounding area of Tarapur Site. Number of beneficiaries would be around 105. So far ₹ 249.79 lakh has been spent on this project.



5.1.13 Construction of toilet block at Chinchani near Tarapur

Construction of toilet block at village Chinchani was carried out which is located in the surrounding area of Tarapur Site. Number of beneficiaries would be around 50000. This will prevent germs from getting into the environment.



5.1.14 Construction of bituminous road at village Kumbhavali near Tarapur

Construction of bituminous and CC road at village Kumbhavali and others were carried out near Tarapur Site. Bituminous road of 1288.50 mtr. length and C C road of 2398.60 mtr. length were constructed. So far ₹ 243.71 lakh has been spent on this project.



5.2 CSR at Rawatbhata Rajasthan Site (RRS)

RRS spent ₹ 2291.35 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2024-25. Using this fund, RRS prepared a CSR plan for the development of neighbourhood area located within 16 Km radius and took up 10 new CSR projects apart from executing 16 on-going projects. This year the CSR activities were undertaken in 147 no. of surrounding villages. Major CSR projects implemented at RRS are given below.

5.2.1 Construction of Government School at Bhainsorgarh near Rawatbhata

Construction of Government School at Bhainsorgarh was carried out. It will benefit around 500 students. This year ₹ 324.16 lakh was spent on the project. The project will reduce

dropout rate.



5.2.2 Construction of Government Senior Secondary School at Mandesara near Rawatbhata

Construction of Government Senior Secondary School at Mandesara was carried out. It will benefit around 850 students. This year ₹ 429.70 lakh was spent on the project. The project will reduce dropout rate.



5.2.3 Distribution of scholarship to talented students near Rawatbhata

Scholarships were reimbursed to talented students of Government Schools. The project has benefitted around 1600 students. This year ₹ 100.75 lakh was spent on the project.

The project will reduce dropout rate.



5.2.4 Bunsen burner at Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Rawatbhata

Bunsen burner was supplied, installed, tested and commissioned at Government Senior Secondary School, Rawatbhata. Number of beneficiaries would be 474. Cost of the project was ₹ 57502.



5.2.5 Training and education for children with special need under UDAAN project

Training for children with special need (CWSN) under UDAAN project was provided at Rawatbhata which would benefit 60 identified children of the surrounding area. This year ₹ 16.57 lakh was spent on the project.



5.2.6 Provision of cleaning equipment to Nagarpalika near Rawatbhata

Garbage collection and cleaning equipment was provided to Nagarpalika, Rawatbhata. Number of beneficiaries would be 37000. This year ₹ 39.80 lakh was spent on the project. This will improve sanitation facilities at the surrounding area.



5.2.7 Construction of Anganwadi Centres near Rawatbhata

Anganwadi centres at Bhainsorgarh, Mandesara, Dhamlav, Kolpura and Parajhar Khurd were constructed near Rawatbhata. Number of beneficiaries would be 250. This year ₹ 209.02 lakh was spent on the project.



5.2.8 Development of pond at village Madarchowk near Rawatbhata

Development of pond at Madarchowk located in Bhainsorgarh panchayat was carried out. Number of beneficiaries would be 1000. This year ₹ 54.08 lakh was spent on the project. The project will be useful for irrigation and ensure availability of drinking water.



5.2.9 Repair of bridge side culvert near Rawatbhata

Repair of bridge side culvert located at the downstream of river Chambal was carried out. This year ₹ 94.38 lakh has been spent on the project and it would benefit around 9580 people. The culvert connects to 15 villages.



5.2.10 Construction of concrete road near Rawatbhata

Infrastructure development work pertaining to concrete road was carried out at the surrounding 25 villages of Site. This year expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 510.54 lakh which would benefit around 43000 persons.



5.2.11 Supply of one small fire tender to Rawatbhata municipality

One small fire tender was supplied to Rawatbhata municipality. The project would benefit around 45000 persons residing near Rawatbhata. Cost of this project was ₹ 21.23 lakh. The project will ensure better availability of infrastructure facilities in surrounding area.



5.3 CSR at Madras Atomic Power Station (MAPS)

MAPS was allocated ₹ 900 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2024-25. Using this fund, MAPS initiated 21 new CSR projects and also executed 17 on-going projects. Some of the major CSR projects implemented at MAPS are given below.

5.3.1 Construction of Panchayat Union Primary School at Mangalam near Kalpakkam

Construction of two class room at Panchayat Union Primary School, Mangalam were carried out which will benefit around 80 students. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 56.97 lakh. This will reduce dropout rate.



5.3.2 Construction of Panchayat Union Middle School at Neikuppi near Kalpakkam

Construction of two class room at Panchayat Union Middle School, Neikuppi were carried out which will benefit around 70 students. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 58.69 lakh. This will reduce dropout rate.



5.3.3 Construction of Panchayat Union Primary School building at Vengappakkam near Kalpakkam

Construction of six class room Panchayat Union Primary School, Vengappakkam was completed. The project will benefit around 300 students. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 141.35 lakh. This will reduce dropout rate and improve education facilities.



5.3.4 Construction of Panchayat Union Middle School building at Mamallapuram near Kalpakkam

Construction of six class room Panchayat Union Middle School, Mamallapuram was completed. The project will benefit around 300 students. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 141.39 lakh. This will reduce dropout rate and improve education facilities.



5.3.5 Distribution of books at Chengai Book Fair near Kalpakkam

Books were distributed by MAPS CSR Cell at Chengai Book Fair to College/ School students. Cost of this project was ₹ 20 lakh. The project benefitted around 160000 students of the surrounding area.



5.3.6 Distribution of peanut burfi to school students near Kalpakkam

Peanut burfi as nutritional supplement were distributed by MAPS CSR Cell to the students of Panchayat Union Middle School, Mamallapuram. Estimated cost of this project is ₹ 40 lakh. The project benefitted around 19000 students.




5.3.7 Construction of Anganwadi at village Neikuppi near Kalpakkam

Construction of Anganwadi with thematic painting and play area was completed at village Neikuppi. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 24.33 lakh. The project will benefit 30 kids. The Anganwadi was inaugurated on 15.07.2024.



5.3.8 Construction of Anganwadi at village Paramasivam Nagar near Kalpakkam

Construction of Anganwadi with thematic painting and play area was completed at village Paramasivam Nagar. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 87.77 lakh. The project will benefit 30 kids. The Anganwadi was inaugurated on 15.07.2024.



5.3.9 Construction of Anganwadi at village Manamai near Kalpakkam

Construction of Anganwadi with thematic painting and play area was completed at village Manamai. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 22.70 lakh. The project will benefit 30 kids. The Anganwadi was inaugurated on 26.04.2024.



5.3.10 Village Service Project at Kunnathur and Villigam near Kalpakkam

Village Service Project was carried out at villages Kunnathur and Villigam. Expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 9.96 lakh. The project will benefit around 10000 villagers of the surrounding area.



5.3.11 Eye Camp near Kalpakkam

Eye camp was organised at Kalpakkam Township through Sankara Nethralaya, Chennai. The project benefitted around 2312 persons of surrounding area. Surgeries carried out for villagers were 205.



5.4 CSR at Narora Atomic Power Station (NAPS)

NAPS spent ₹ 1428.41 lakh out of allocated ₹ 1205 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2024-25. Using this fund, NAPS prepared a CSR plan for the development of neighbourhood area and took up 6 new projects and 17 on-going projects. Some of the CSR projects implemented at NAPS are given below.

5.4.1 Distribution of notebooks to school students near Narora

Notebooks were distributed to the students of schools located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. The project has benefitted students of nearby area. This has improved education quality in the surrounding area and has reduced dropout rate.



5.4.2 Skill development training to the youth residing near Narora

Skill development training is being provided by National Small Industries Corporation- Technical Services Centre, Aligarh to the youth on 18 courses. Total no. of beneficiaries of this project would be 704. Job mela was also conducted.



5.4.3 OPD Services at Narora Township

OPD services at Community Centre of Narora Township and free eye camps were conducted in the surrounding area of Narora. Around 30000 villagers have been benefitted by this project. This year ₹ 7.73 lakh was spent on the project.



5.4.4 TB elimination program near Narora

The TB elimination by the year 2025 is an ambitious project of the Government of India to improve the health parameters of the country and make the lives of its citizen better and healthy. Accordingly, TB elimination program was implemented in the villages.



5.4.5 Assisting differently abled persons near Narora

Distribution camp was conducted for differently abled persons including senior citizens for providing assistive devices through ALIMCO. The project benefitted 333 persons and expenditure incurred so far on this project was ₹ 37.18 lakh.



5.4.6 Construction of RCC storm water drain near Narora






