

The validity period of EC granted to this Project was valid for 5 years to start production operations by the project, however, you have requested for the extension of validity by another 5 years i.e. upto 30.12.2019 as per procedure prescribed in the EIA Notification, 2006. You have also submitted updated Form-I and Prefeasibility Report for unit 5-6 for 2x1000 MWe.


