

MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS OF NPCIL IN JANUARY 2020

1. Generation by all units of NPCIL up to 31.01.2020 in FY 2019-20 was 39245 MU, which crossed the earlier highest ever commercial generation of 38336 MU in FY 2017-18.
2. Generation by all units of NPCIL was 3437 MUs during the month.
3. Eleven Reactors registered 100% Availability Factor during the month.
4. As on January 31, 2020, KAPS-2 (496 days) and NAPS-2 (524 days) continued operating for more than a year. The continuous operation of more than a year has so far been achieved 32 times by various reactors operated by NPCIL.
5. Moderator system draining is completed after obtaining AERB clearance in KAPP-3.
6. A major milestone i.e. "Calandria Tube installation" is completed in RAPP-8.
7. Thirteenth & fourteenth Break Bulk Vessel containing around 8750 FRT (Freight Ton) project cargo and Fifteenth and sixteenth Break Bulk Vessel containing around 9300 FRT (Freight Ton) project cargo arrived at Tuticorin port on January 14, 2020 and January 22, 2020 respectively for KKNPP-3&4
8. KGS-1&2 has received National Safety Council of India (NSCI) safety award-2019 "Sarva Shrestha Suraksha Puraskar" (Golden trophy) from National Safety Council, Mumbai.
9. KGS-3&4 won the prestigious Shrestha Suraksha Puraskar (Silver trophy and Certificate), NSCI safety award-2019 from National Safety Council.
10. Public outreach during this month for public awareness activities is around 7.18 lakhs and cumulative figure till January 31,2020 is around 51.7 lakhs for the financial year 2019-20.
