During the empanelment period (from 3rd Oct 2024 to 2nd Oct. 2027), the respective Unit/Sites/HQ will enter into MoU with IBPS whenever requirement arises to conduct recruitment examination. Separate MoU will be entered into for each recruitment project. 3	<b>Name of the Work:</b>	<b>Estimated Cost:</b>	M/s Bhagwat constructions, Narora	30 Days	<p>In KGS-2, during unit operating condition oil leak was observed in bearing No-4 Jacking Oil Pump (JOP) line elbow weld joint. Attempts were made for arresting the oil leak but leak could not be arrested. In view of oil leak from the JOP line, turbine and reactor was manual tripped for attending the leak on 22/06/2025. During turbine coast down, at around 300rpm bearing No-4 Babbitt Metal temperature spiked to around 150 Deg C, which is above the melting point of turbine bearing babbitt metal. In view of above it is expected that bearing No-4 liner need replacement before unit start-up. Approval was obtained from Station Director KGS 1&amp;2 for the above.</p> <p>This is specialized job and requires expert manpower to execute the job. Bearing liner replacement job of turbine is normally carried out in BSD through external contract by specialized agency/ contractor. As this is critical path activity and unit start-up can not be done without executing the job, hence this job need to be executed of URGENT basis.</p> <p>As is operation breakdown job (which was not planned originally), hence no existing contract is available with KGS-1&amp;2 for execution of this job. Without execution of this job unit of KGS-2 can not be started. Hence any delay in execution of this job will directly result in revenue loss. Also normal tendering process for award of contract for execution of above job will need significant time period, which increase unit outage and loss of revenue. Hence it is proposed to award the contract for above job on Nomination without call of tender to reduce the time delay in award of the contract.</p> <p>M/s BHEL (OEM of turbine) was requested for execution of above work &amp; for immediate mobilization of team, which is crucial to meet the plant start-up timeline. However, the M/s BHEL via e-mail dated 23/06/2025 has expressed their inability to depute the required team due to pre-occupied works. Subsequent to denial of OEM, M/s Bhagwat construction (BHEL approved sub-vendor) is approached to execute above job and for deployment of man-power on immediate basis. M/s Bhagwat had recently carried out same/ similar job at KGS-1&amp;2 in BSD 2022, 2023 &amp; 2024. Presently M/s Bhagwat is executing TG overhauling works at KAPS site and ready to depute his man-power within 2-3 days. M/s Bhagwat construction is approved sub-vender of M/s BHEL and regularly carried out similar jobs of same make &amp; model turbines at various units of NPCIL hence he is technically capable for the above work.</p> <p>Estimation of the proposed contract value is carried out on the basis of latest Work Order No. 303371 dtd. 12.09.2024. As the individual item of proposed job is not available in the above referred work order, hence engineering estimate of percentage of quantum of work covered in work order SOQR item is considered. Which comes to the value of around 44,29,862/- (Rupees forty-four lakhs twenty nine thousand eight hundred and sixty two only) inclusive of GST @18%. As per HQI 2015-R1, Part-2 clause 7(d), approval from Station Director KGS 1&amp;2 was obtained for "Carrying out Turbine Bearing-4 inspection during PSD of KGS-2" on Nomination basis without call of tender.</p> <p>Considering urgency of the work, tender was sent by e-mail (bhagwatprasadyadav60@gmail.com) and quotation was taken from the party by email.</p> <p>Operational emergency addressed by awarding Work Order-303406 to the contractor on 24/06/2025. Contractor man-power reached the Kaiga site in night of 25/06/2025 and stated work in field from 26/06/2025 after completion of gate pass formalities.</p> <p>Work was successfully completed in all respect on 05/07/2025.
